



## 2011 Mike Schmidt Winner's Circle Invitational



You are cordially invited to be part of the twelfth annual Mike Schmidt Winner's Circle Invitational benefiting the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Baseball legend Mike Schmidt established the Winner's Circle in memory of Brett Weinstein who lost his battle against cystic fibrosis in 1999.

The fishing competition will take place May 12 - 14, 2011 at Old Bahama Bay Resort at West End. You'll be joining a great group of people who all love to fish and relax and enjoy life in the islands.

Anglers will have a sendoff breakfast each morning and a welcome cocktail when returning each evening. The three days of competitive fishing will be capped off by the Awards Banquet on Saturday, May 14. The field is limited to 40 boats, with returning participants given preference.

Daily prizes will be awarded for the largest Dolphin, Tuna, and Wahoo. Grand Prize Champion will be the boat that weighs in the greatest total weight of one each of three species Dolphin, Tuna, and Wahoo. There will be a meeting the evening of May 11 at Old Bahama Bay to review tournament rules.

The Winner's Circle Kickoff Party will be held on Saturday, May 7 in Jupiter. This year's party will have a change of pace: the auction format is on hiatus until the economy turns around. It will be an entertaining evening of live music, dancing, great food and fun. Boat entries are entitled to up to 8 guests at the Kickoff Party.

Complete event schedule, rules, and other information will be sent when entries are confirmed. Marina reservations will be made for you for the four days of the tournament. If you plan to arrive prior to May 11, please notify the OBB Marina. Customs and Immigrations packets will be available in early May.
